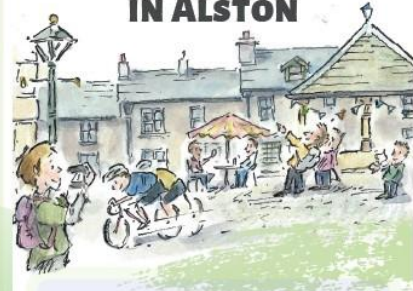

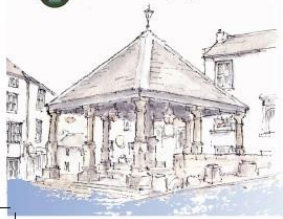
FRONT STREET - MAIN SHOPPING AREA
